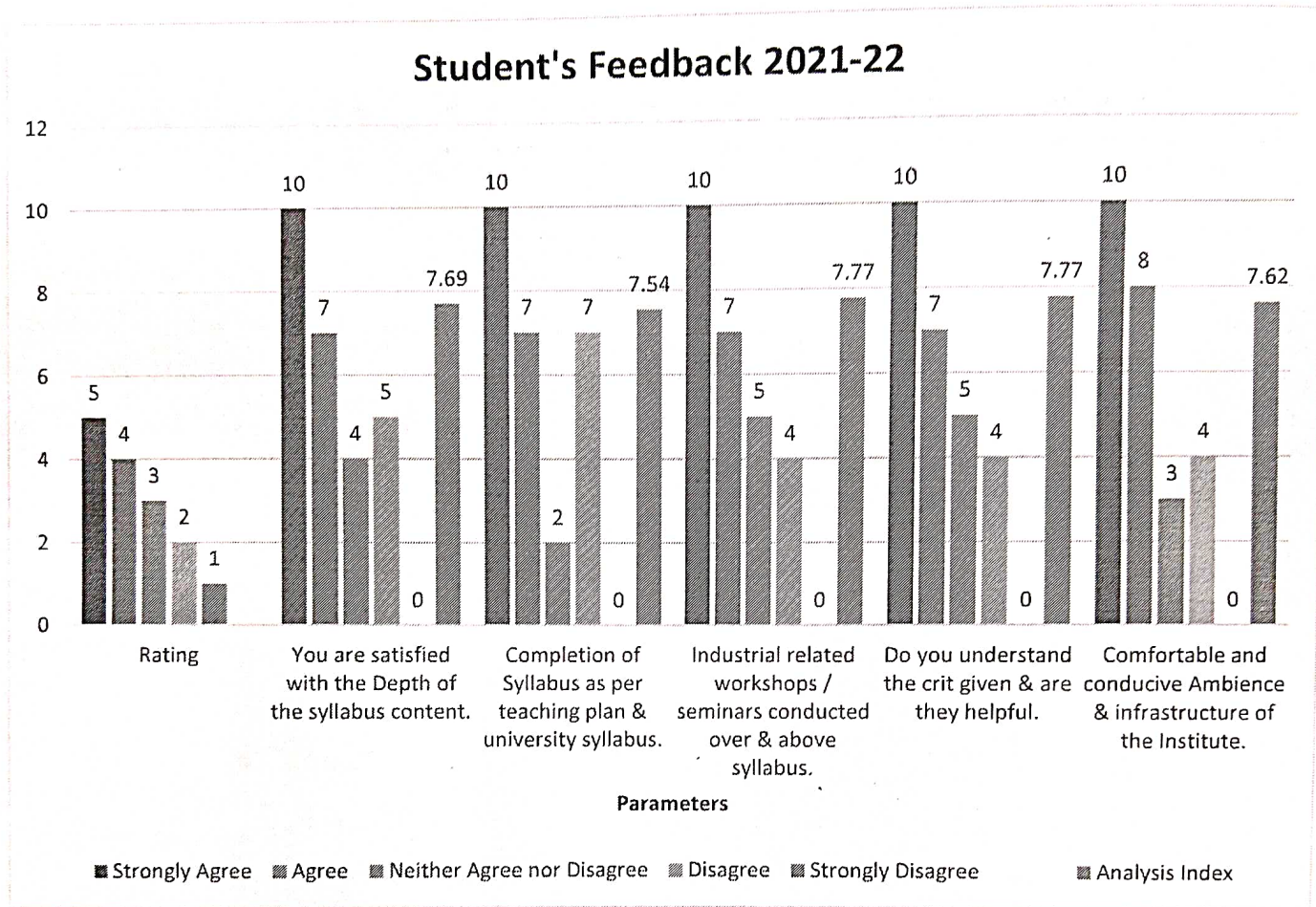

Graphical Analysis of the Student's feedback:

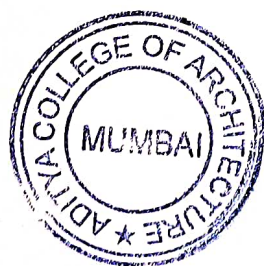

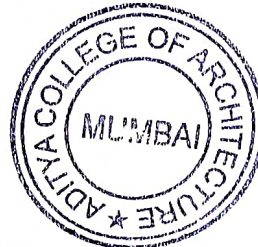

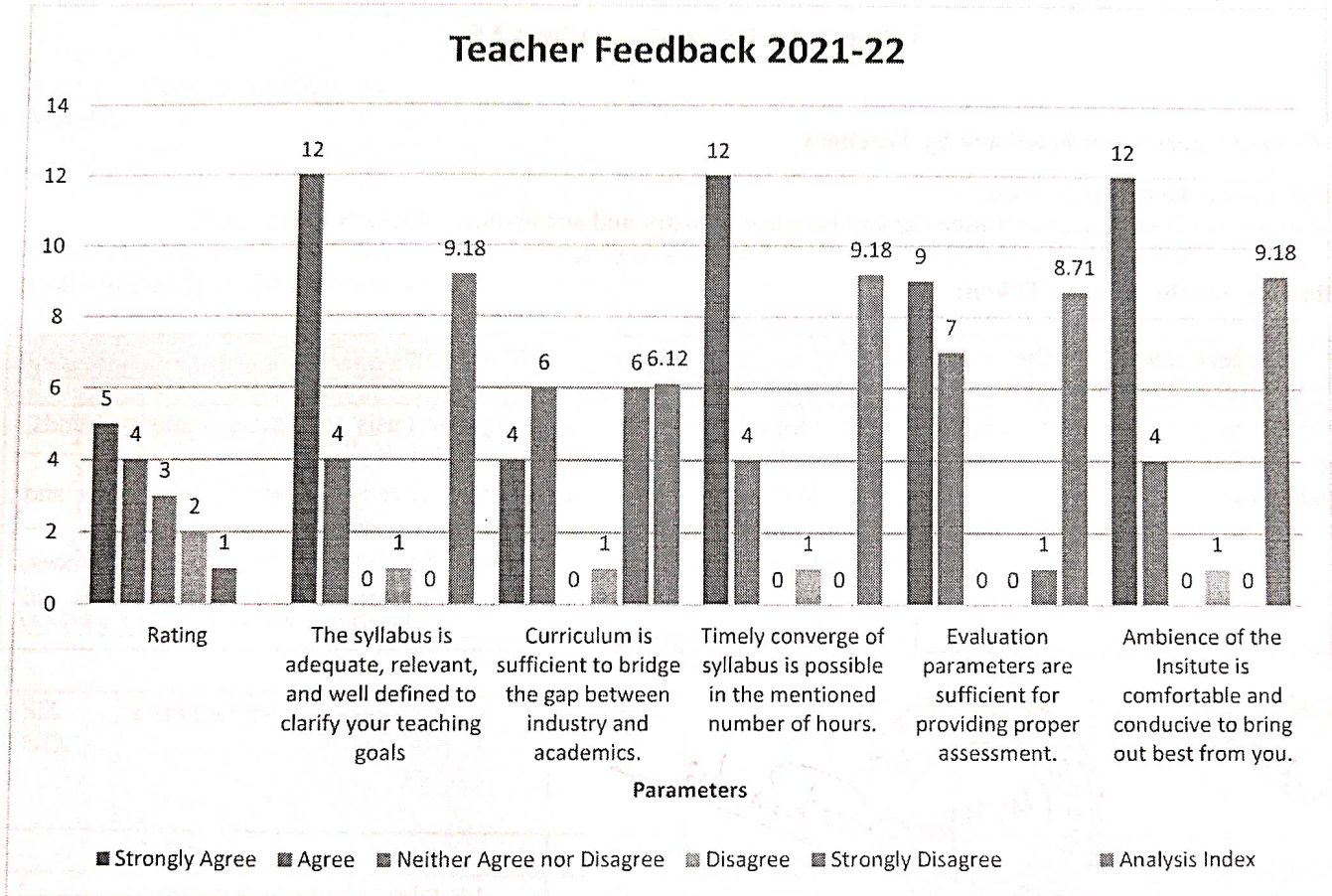

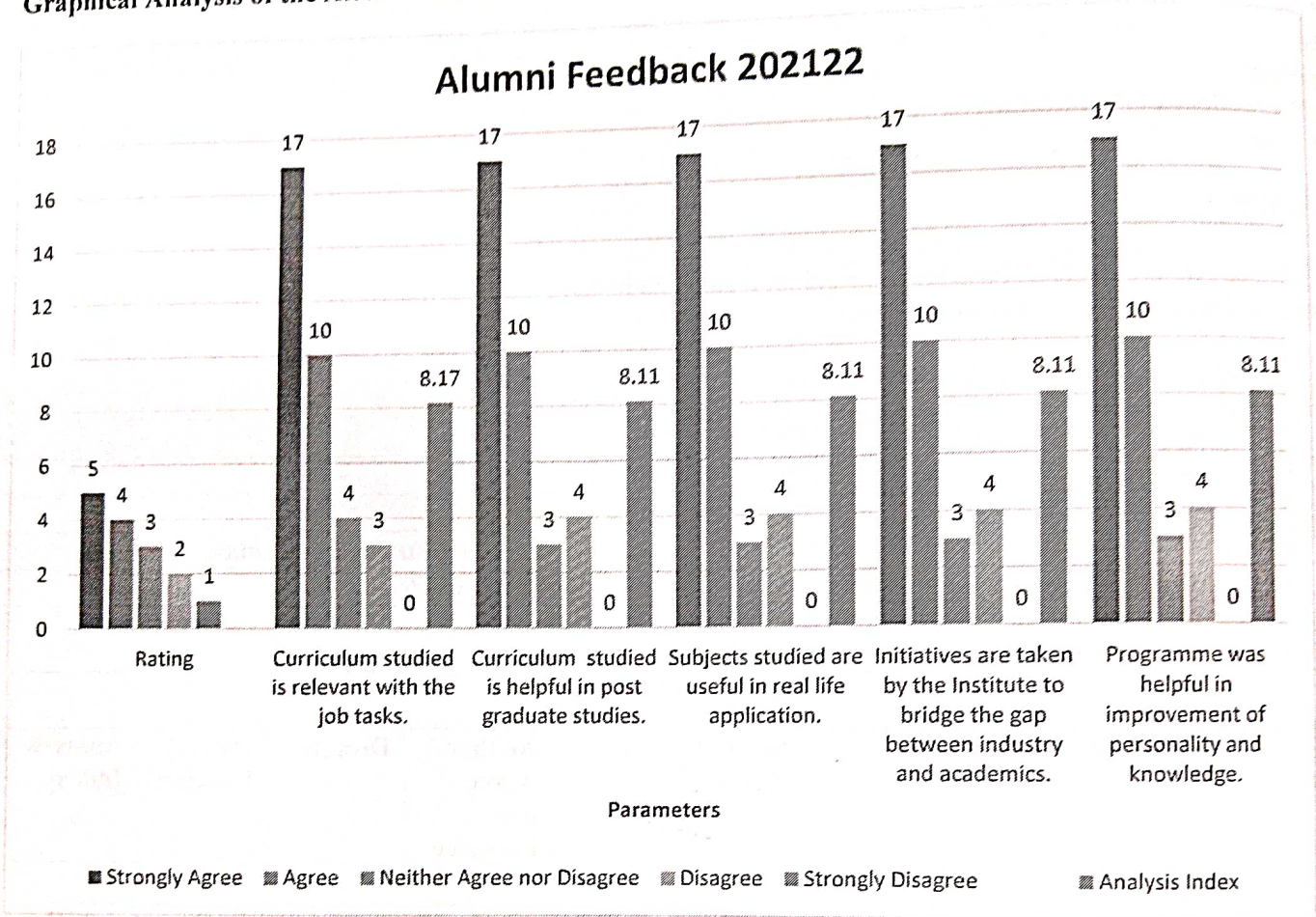

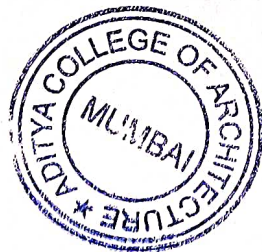
Graphical Analysis of the Employer's feedback:
